# WELCOME TO THE NEW SCOUT COMMUNITY HALL

# 1.30pm to 3.30pm Saturday 18 September 2021

After many years of fund raising, bad weather, the highs and lows of grant funding applications, and a pandemic we have finally

have a new Scout Community Hall fully that is accessible and meets all modern



required standards of community building.

It has been a long journey but we can now celebrate success. The Journey started many years ago but raising sufficient funds for a new building was a major challenge. However, the Seaton Community have given strong community support and been instrumental have helping to raise funds. The biggest being a beguest of £30,000 which really kick started the project for a new build. We then went on to raise funds through a significant number of Grant Bodies including Cumbria Foundation, Community Parish Council, Garfield Weston, Sunley, Bernard Allerdale Council and the Big Lottery. In total we raised £250,000.

The contract for the build was awarded to Stobbart Construction the13th and September 2019 was a great day for the Seaton Scout Group when two Beavers scouts cut the first turf to much celebration. Little did we know what would follow!

So began our tortuous Journey from old to new. It started with prolonged bad weather soaking the site and we continued to operate from the 'Old Shack'. Then, in January 2020, two significant storms damaged the old hut and it could no longer be used. It was shortly after that the Pandemic lockdown started.

Would we ever get there? Yes we did thanks to the Support of John Stobbart, his Team and many others!

Our new building has a 105sqM hall, good sized modern kitchen, modern toilets including accessible toilet and an Indoor/ A gentle exercise class for over Out space in the form of a multipurpose garage for storage and use on wet days by the Group. arounds have landscaped and even the grass is growing!

We want to celebrate a little, to say 'thank you' and show off the new building that is open for use by the whole community. You are therefore welcome to come and see us from 1.30pm to 3.30pm on Saturday 18 September 2021 to have a look around and enjoy some refreshments.
